These fun and informative painting workshops are held every month, usually on the first Thursday of the month, 10am to 3.30pm in the Tom Hauley Room* Harbury

From expert to complete novice, all are welcome - Nick gives individual and collective assistance when needed. Nick provides the day's subject, explains how we are going to tackle it and then guides us step by step through the stages of producing our paintings. We start at the very reasonable hour of 10am and usually finish around 3.30pm. We have a couple of tea breaks and a short break for lunch (tea, coffee & biscuits are supplied - bring your own packed lunch). At the end of the day we compare notes and discuss how we all got on.

The cost of a workshop is currently £12 per person, payable in cash on the day. The workshops are usually based on watercolour, but we occasionally use coloured pencils, pens, gouache and acrylics. You do not need to have a lot of equipment, and if you are a beginner we can advise you what to buy before your first session.

You do not have to attend every month – you just book a place for the particular workshops you want to attend.
